A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TALBOT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER & SEWER PLAN, AS ADOPTED BY TALBOT COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 100, TO INCLUDE THE SUBSIDIARY PLAN TO THE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER AND SEWERAGE PLAN FOR CHANGE OF PROPERTY STATUS FOR THE TOWN OF TRAPPE – TRAPPE EAST WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, IN THE THIRD ELECTION DISTRICT, TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND; PURSUANT TO THE POWER AND AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ARTICLE, TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 5, OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TALBOT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER & SEWER PLAN, AS ADOPTED BY TALBOT COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 100, TO INCLUDE THE SUBSIDIARY PLAN TO THE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER AND SEWERAGE PLAN FOR CHANGE OF PROPERTY STATUS FOR THE TOWN OF TRAPPE – TRAPPE EAST WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, IN THE THIRD ELECTION DISTRICT, TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND; PURSUANT TO THE POWER AND AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ARTICLE, TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 5, OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND

WHEREAS, the County Council of Talbot County, State of Maryland, by Resolution No. 100 has adopted the October 2002 Report of the Review of the Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan (the “Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Trappe Subsidiary Plan to the Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan for the Trappe East Water and Sewer District includes Tax Map 59, Parcel 1 and Tax Map 55, Parcels 14, 15, 17, 19, 44, 65, and 66 to be classified as W-1, immediate priority status for water service; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Trappe Subsidiary Plan to the Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan for the Trappe East Water and Sewer District includes Tax Map 59, Parcel 1 and Tax Map 55, Parcels 14, 15, 17, 19, 44, 65, and 66 to be classified as S-1, immediate priority status for sewer service; and

WHEREAS, Talbot County has verified that, including the facility approved by this amendment, water and sewer service to its Immediate Priority (W-1 and S-1) Schedule will be properly planned, controlled, and regulated; and

WHEREAS, the Talbot County Council has considered the request, and hereby approves the same, subject to the terms of this Resolution and compliance with applicable design and technical requirements, rules, and regulations of all local, state, and federal authorities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland as follows:

Section 1. The Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan shall be amended to include the Town of Trappe Subsidiary Plan to the Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan for the Trappe East Water and Sewer District.

Section 2. The Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan shall be amended to include immediate priority status for water and sewer service (W-1 and S-1) extensions in the jurisdiction of the Trappe Water and Wastewater System to the following areas:

- a) TAX MAP 59, PARCEL 1
- b) TAX MAP 55, PARCELS 14, 15, 17, 19, 44, 65, and 66

Section 3. The Amendment, related to the immediate priority status for water and sewer utility extensions, shall be in accordance with the attached additions and changes and shall be permanently entered into the currently effective Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan as part of Chapters 1, 2, and 3.

Section 4. Adoption of this amendment, by the County Council of Talbot County, shall authorize the construction of the projects in accordance with and subject to the approval of the Municipal, County, State, and/or Federal agencies, as may be required, effective from the date of adoption.

Be It Further Resolved that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its date of passage.
